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#### EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE SYSTEM (EIS) / SISTEM INSURANS PEKERJAAN (SIP)

We wish to advise that EIS/SIP will be implemented wef January 2018.

#### WHAT IS EIS/SIP?

EIS/SIP is a social security network, managed by PERKESO, set-up to help workers who have lost their jobs by providing them with:

- (a) financial assistance; and
- (b) job search, career counselling and job suitability support services.

Contributions from both employers and employees towards EIS/SIP shall be  $\underline{\text{mandatory wef January}}$  2018.

#### **SALIENT POINTS**

EMPLOYERS	All private sector employers having one or more employees must register and contribute to this new scheme.	
EMPLOYEES	All employees aged between 18 years to 60 years old must contribute to this scheme, except for the following categories of employees:  (a) Employees aged 57 years and above and no contributions has been paid before reaching 57 years.  (b) Members of the public service of the Federation and the States  (c) Employees of local authorities or statutory bodies  (d) Civil servants and Domestic servants  (e) Self-employed	
REGISTRATION (by completing the relevant SIP forms *)	New Employers (New employers are NOT SOCSO-registered)  (a) SIP 1 Form – Employer's registration form	

## **SALIENT POINTS (CONT'D)**

CONTRIBUTION RATE	1. The contribution rate for SIP is 0.4% of the employee's monthly salary a follows:	
	<ul><li>Employer - 0.2%</li><li>Employee - 0.2%</li></ul>	
	2. The Contribution Table (Second Schedule of Section 18) is attached (Refer Attachment 2.2)	
	3. The contributions to the fund is capped at a salary level of RM4,000 a month	
SIP SUBMISSION & PAYMENT	<ol> <li>Submissions and payments of SIP are due on or before 15th of every month</li> <li>The 1<sup>st</sup> SIP contribution shall commence wef the January 2018 salary (i.e. due 15 Feb 18)</li> </ol>	
	3. Fines not exceeding RM10,000 or a imprisonment term of 2 years may be imposed for non-compliance with the SIP rules.	
	Note: SIP and normal SOCSO contributions are to be submitted separately.
